The Best Time for a Spring Lawn Cleanup in Fargo

Aerating penetrates the soil and primes it to effectively receive nutrients, water, and air essential in growing solid roots.

After aeration, overseeding fills your lawn and improves and sustains its endurance and color. Collectively, aerating and overseeding repairs the winter's damages.

3. Trimming and Pruning

Think of trimming and pruning as your lawns after winter makeover! Your yard will look better, and shrubs and trees will be healthier! This is the part of your lawn's spring cleanup process when any found diseased or dead plant tissue (roots, buds, branches, buds, etc.) are

Compacted soil prevents the absorption of what your lawn needs for healthier, thicker grass growth. Grass roots require nutrients, water, and air to thrive, and even a layer of 1/4 to 1/2 inch of compacted soil can take an enormous toll on the beauty and health of your lawn. Aerating your lawn mitigates soil compaction and allows nutrients, water, and air to reach grass roots. In Fargo and other Upper Midwest areas, soil compaction is expected because our soil is mainly clay.

The Best Time for Lawn Aeration Cleanup in Fargo

When it comes to northern lawns, like ours in Fargo, early fall or spring are the best times for soil aeration. And aerating is easiest when your soil is moist.

Other times soil aeration may be required is when your grass frequently looks stressed, your soil feels hard to the touch, or you notice the puddling of rainwater where absorption used to occur. These signs may indicate that your soil is compacted. The "screwdriver test" can confirm compaction problems. Using your hand, stick a regular screwdriver into your lawn's soil. If it doesn't slide in easily, your soil is compacted, and aeration is needed.

What Happens When a Lawn Gets Aerated?

Putting 2 – 3" holes in your turf during aeration mitigates the compaction of your soil, allowing water, nutrients, and air to reach your lawn's root system. And when your grass gets what it needs, you get a beautiful yard that'll be the envy of the neighborhood.

Aeration Enhances:

- The exchange of oxygen between the soil and the atmosphere. This results in healthier grass roots
- The ability of fertilizer to nourish the root system
- Root health below ground. The crucial element for healthy grass
- Helps your grass withstand disease, drought, and heat
- The effectiveness of overseeding by allowing direct contact between soil and seed.
